## Quarterly State of the Company

### Q1 Finance Update

Through the first quarter, we completed 542,522 scans on a budget of 560,855. There were some weather challenges this quarter that contributed to the budget shortfall, but we expect to be able to make up ground between now and the end of the year. MRI and PET/CT have performed especially well, allowing us to achieve our net patient revenue budget of \$140.7M through Q1. We're continuing to see solid growth across many of our centers, and volumes have remained strong as we move into Q2.

Also, we're glad to celebrate the opening of our newest center, Keller Parkway, which opened in the Texas region in March of this year. Expanding into new communities allows us to continue increasing access to high-quality imaging services and care for even more patients. We're excited about the momentum we're building together in 2026.

## **Q1 Company ROCK Update**

While no new company-level ROCKs were formally established for Q1 2026, our efforts remained focused on advancing the Rezolut integration while maintaining execution across the Envision core business. By the end of Q2, remote scanning will move from concept to an operational capability within our organization. This is not simply a technology initiative—it is a strategic lever that supports our North Star.

Remote scanning enables us to:

- Expand patient access and reduce delays in care
- Improve throughput and to better utilize existing capacity
- Create a more flexible and sustainable model for our technologists
- Deliver a more consistent and reliable experience for patients and providers

As we scale this capability, it will support our ability to grow responsibly, strengthen our teams, and continue becoming the preferred imaging partner in the communities we serve. At its core, this is about supporting our teams and expanding access for patients—and as we do that well, we also build long-term value for our employee-owners.

The accounting team is fine-tuning how we monitor our finances across the organization. This includes standardizing how financial activity is reported, creating consistent financial statements, strengthening our forecasting capabilities, and building a clearer view of our overall financial structure to better guide future investment decisions.

Jeff Emery and the IT team have begun reviewing new technology platforms designed to streamline how work is organized, documented, and completed. They're evaluating how well each option manages workflows, supports users, automates routine tasks, and integrates with our broader systems. This work will help our teams operate more efficiently and further align our North Star with the experience we aim to deliver to those we serve.

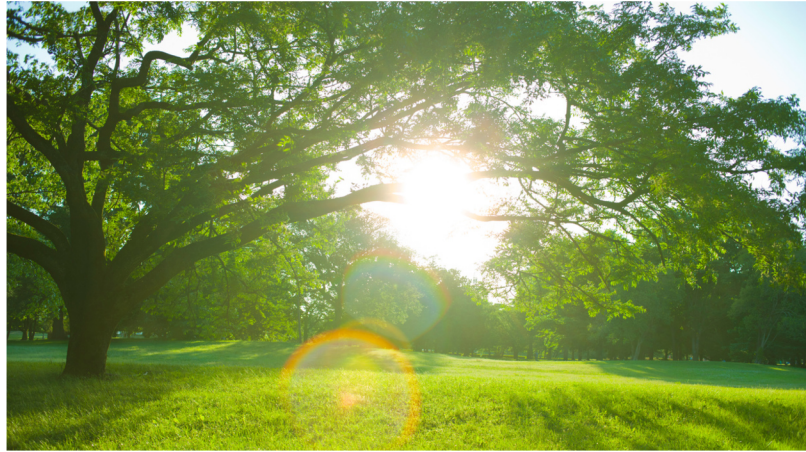


## Tim Fielding, PMO Director Working Together to Move Forward

In March, we opened a beautiful new Envision Imaging center in Keller, Texas.

This new facility brings a 3.0 Tesla MRI to the market and also offers ultrasound, mammography, and bone density services. We also expanded our Las Colinas location in March by adding mammography and additional ultrasound capacity, further increasing access to high-quality, patient-centered care.

And there is more ahead! We are preparing to open a new Envision Imaging center in Coppell, Texas, with an anticipated opening in October 2026. This week alone, two more major projects were approved, bringing our total to 10 approved

It is important to remember that these are not just regional wins. They are wins for our entire organization. Whether growth happens in New York, California, Texas, or anywhere else across the country, it gives all of us something to celebrate together.

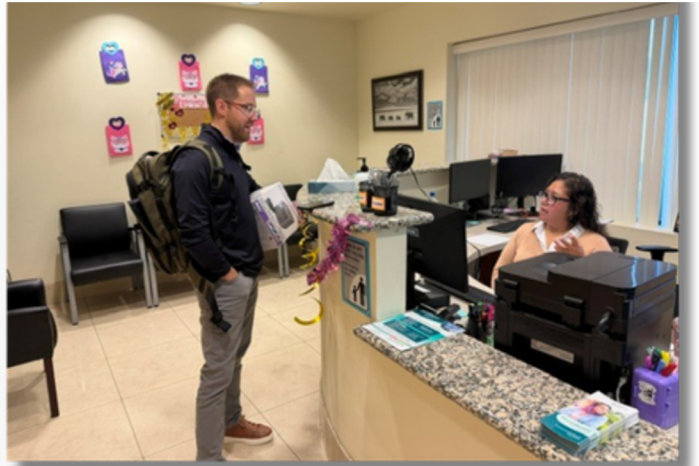

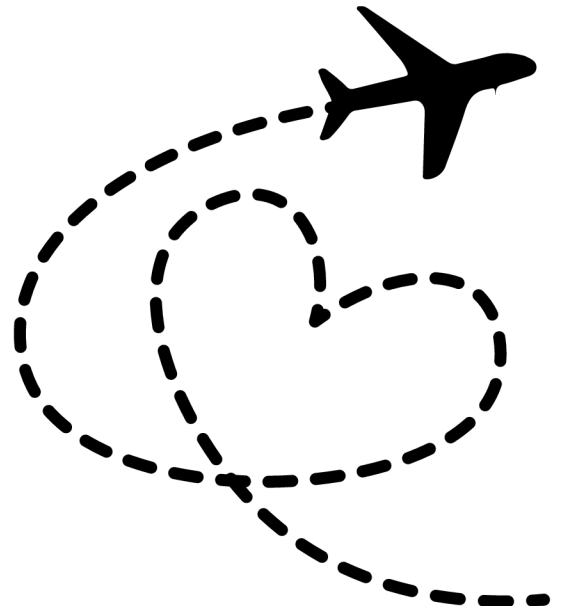
